The Santa Maria Water District (SMWD) hereinafter referred to as "the Purchaser", through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), invite interested parties to submit price quotation for the project, **"RENOVATION AND REPAIR OF VARIOUS SMWD PUMP STATIONS AND PROPOSED DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT ON THE RIGHT OF WAY OF MANGGAHAN PUMP STATION"** through Small Value Procurement (Sec. 53.9 of R.A. No. 9184) with Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Five Hundred Three Thousand One Hundred Five and Forty One Centavos Only **(P503, 105.41)**.

All projects listed under the purchaser’s specifications must be complied on a pass-fail basis.

Failure to meet any one of the requirements will result to rejection. Likewise, it is understood that Purchaser’s specifications are minimum requirements. The Bidder/Supplier may offer higher specifications.

Procurement procedures will be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (Government Procurement Reform Act).

It is the intent of the Purchaser to evaluate the quotation for the project and award will be made to the quotation resulting in the overall lowest cost. Contract Award will be made to the lowest evaluated quotation meeting purchaser’s technical specifications.

Likewise, in accordance with Section 54.6 and Appendix A of Annex "H" (Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement) of the IRR of RA No. 9184, the supplier shall provide the following documentary requirements as a **condition for award** of the contract:

1. PhilGEPS Registration Number; and
2. Mayor’s/Business Permit.
3. Photo Copy of Sample Official Receipt (OR)
4. Certificate of Registration (BIR FORM 2303)
5. Duly Notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement.

Your prices must be quoted in Philippine Peso and must include the unit price and total price, inclusive of all taxes to be paid and other incidental cost to the delivery site if the contract is awarded.

All quotations may be typewritten or handwritten and may be placed in sealed envelope marked **“RENOVATION AND REPAIR OF VARIOUS SMWD PUMP STATIONS AND PROPOSED DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT ON THE RIGHT OF WAY OF MANGGAHAN PUMP STATION”** (RFQ No. 2021-036B) and must be submitted on or before **July 9, 2021, 11:00AM** at the SMWD main office. It may also be sent thru email on our official email address at smwdbulacan@yahoo.com on the specified time stated above and address to the General Manager, Engr. Carlos N. Santos Jr.



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Quotations shall be valid for thirty (30) calendar days from the deadline of submission of the same.

PROJECT SITE: Kalsadang Munti Pump Station, Villarica Pump Station, Gulod, Poblacion Pump Station and Manggahan Pump Station.

The prospective supplier shall submit the duly accomplished Quotation Form (*Attachment A*).

The Santa Maria Water District reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation, and to annul the procurement process and reject all quotations at any time prior to Contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected supplier or suppliers. SMWD also reserves the right to waive any required formality in the proposals received, and select the proposal which it determines to be the most advantageous to the government.
